First to Fifth Form - Academic Uniform

Hair and Appearance (First and Second Form)

- Hair should be natural looking and not inappropriate in style;
- Students should have their hair tied back at all times;
- Make-up is not allowed;
- No nail varnish should be worn;
- Earrings should be studs and only one pair in the earlobe. No other jewellery should be worn unless under medical or religious obligation;
- For health and safety reasons, body piercings may not be worn at any time.

Hair and Appearance (Third Form, Fourth Form and Fifth Form)

- Hair should be natural looking, not inappropriate in style;
- Students must be clean-shaven;
- Stud earrings, one necklace, one bracelet and a signet ring may be worn;
- For health and safety reasons, body piercings may not be worn at any time.

Sixth Form - Academic Uniform

Suits

- Monotone colours required: black, navy, grey, pinstriped;
- Subtle patterns such as houndstooth, herringbone and twill are allowed;
- Waistcoats are allowed;
- Jackets must be worn at all times around campus but may be removed during lessons.

Shirts

- Must not be an outlandish colour or design;
- Must be tucked in with top button done up;
- Cufflinks may be worn.

Jumpers

- You may wear a plain smart jumper over your shirt or blouse and under your jacket;
- Sweatshirts and informal jumpers are not permitted;
- Jumpers are not to be worn on their own and must be worn with a shirt or blouse.

Ties

- Must be worn with shirt;
- Should not be outlandish in colour or design,

Footwear

- Shoes must maintain a professional appearance while offering comfort and practicality. Accordingly, footwear should be smart/formal, plain black or brown and polishable;
- Boots may be worn but should not exceed a height slightly above the ankle. Heels are permissible but should not surpass a height of two inches (non-stiletto heel) to ensure safety and stability while navigating school premises. Laces must be plain in design.

OR

Jacket or Blazer

- Must be worn at all times around campus but may be removed during lessons;
- Does not have to be part of a suit and does not need to have buttons;
- Can be any length or colour but not leather or fur.

Trousers

- Can be patterned, plain, pinstripe or any colour;
- Must not be shorter than the knee:
- Must not be leggings, jogging bottoms, denim, leather, cord or have holes or tears.

Skirts

- Do not need to match jacket/blazer;
- Skirts should be of an appropriate length and on the knee;
- Can be patterned or plain and any colour;
- Must **not** be denim, leather, cord or a tube skirt;
- Must **not** have buttons or a zip down the front.

Blouse or Shirt

- Must provide adequate coverage;
- Can be pattered, plain or any colour;
- You may wear a thin jumper or cardigan over your blouse and under your jacket;
- T-shirts, vest top, crop top and other revealing garments or clothing made from transparent materials are not permitted.

Tailored Dress

General PE Kit

- Can be patterned, plain or any colour;
- Should be of an appropriate length and on the knee;
- Can be worn with or without a blouse underneath;
- Must not have cut-outs or be backless;
- Cannot be a sundress, bodycon dress, skater dress, woollen dress or maxi dress.

Hair and Appearance (Sixth Form)

- There is a 'rule of three' maximum three rings, three necklaces, three earrings, and three bracelets;
- Hair should be natural in colour not inappropriate in style;
- Students must be clean shaven;
- Make up discreet and only clear nail varnish may be worn;
- Ankle bracelets may not be worn;
- No other visible piercings or tattoos;
- For health and safety reasons, body piercings may not be worn at any time.
